

Here are our notes on some of the visible procedures that we flagged in the snapshot above:

- 1. Maggie warmly greets each student at the door with a handshake
- Students know that the expectations are to enter silently and in a single-file line
- 3. Lesson packets are located on a desk near the entry to ensure students have everything they need for the lesson by the time they reach their seat
- 4. One student is already sitting and copying the objective before she starts the Do Now. She's able to get right to work in part because she knows exactly where to look for both the objective and the Do Now. They're posted in the same place every day (on the board)
- Students who have backpacks or jackets hang them up on hangers in the back of the classroom. This ensures that aisle ways stay clear and clutter-free for a smooth entry
